Small Group Counseling - Elementary School Counseling

Group counseling is typically a small group of no more than 10 participants and 1-2 group leaders, usually therapists, engage in a psychosocial form of counseling. Small group counseling is held 1-2 times per week and involves talking and listening to each other's concerns and progress.

Group counseling seeks to give students a safe and comfortable place on campus where they can work out problems and emotional concerns. Group therapy involves one or more psychologists who lead a group of roughly five to 15 patients. Typically, groups meet for an hour or two each week. Some people attend individual therapy in addition to groups, while others participate in groups only.

Psychotherapy: Understanding group therapy

Students for small group counseling can be referred through the MTSS behavioral system, teacher referrals or administration referrals. Students are selected based on need and/or grade level assessments. Groups are typically up to 8 sessions, but could be more depending on the student's needs.

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
