St. Mary Romanian Orthodox Chatedral. Romanians from Transylvania, Banat and Bucovina, then provinces of the Hapsburg Empire, as well as some from Macedonia, arrived in America in the late 1800s. Like other nationalities, Romanians also had their own pioneers in the New World. By 1748, when the first Greeks were settling in Florida, "a priest from Transylvania, belonging to the Greek Orthodox Church", Fr. Samuil Damian, is mentioned by Benjamin Franklin.
